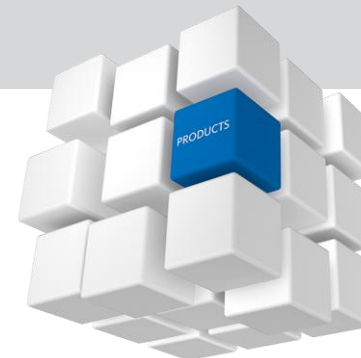

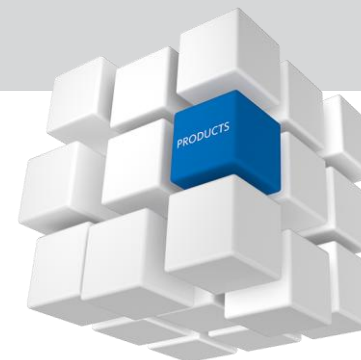

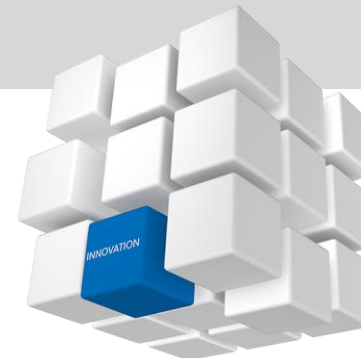

- **1924** Fold&Slide hardware is registered as a patent
- **1938** BKS develops the round cylinder – the first modern locking cylinder system
- **1950** BKS launches a panic lock which is the first of its kind worldwide
- **1958** Invention of the Lift&Slide hardware
- **1979** Development of the GU-SECURY multi-point door lock

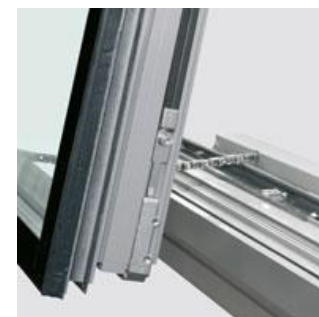

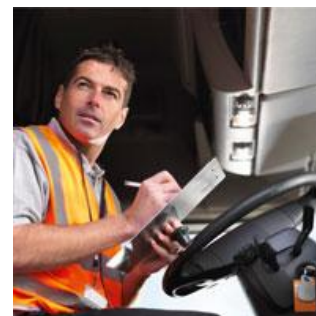

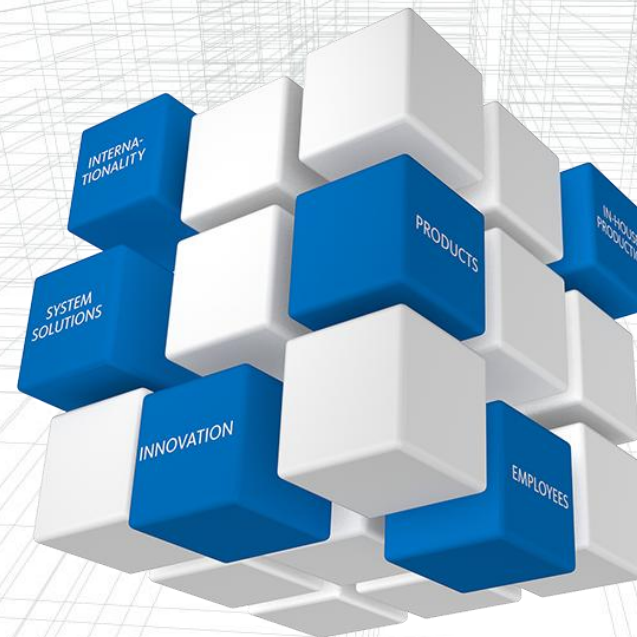
